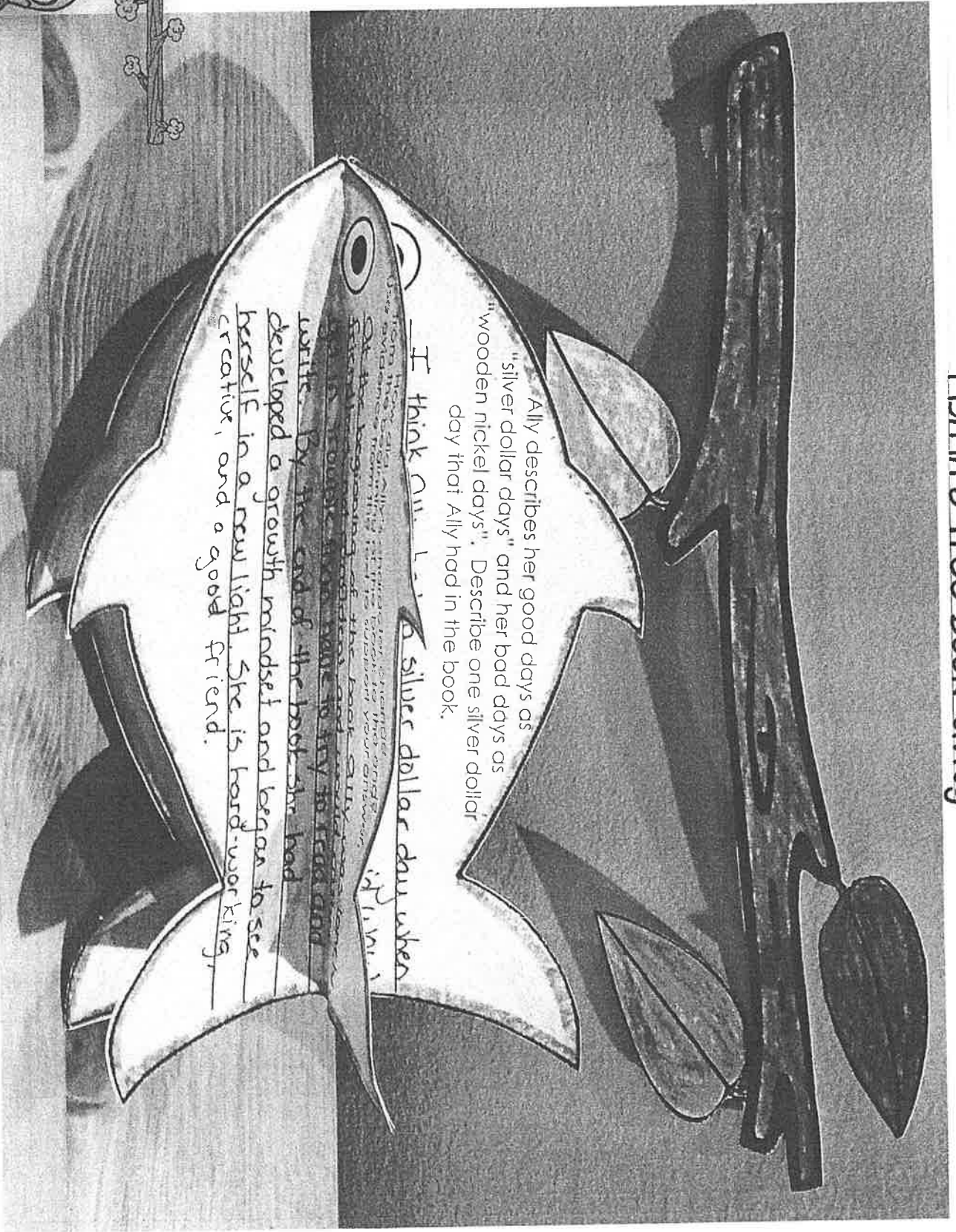


# Fish in a Tree Book-tivity

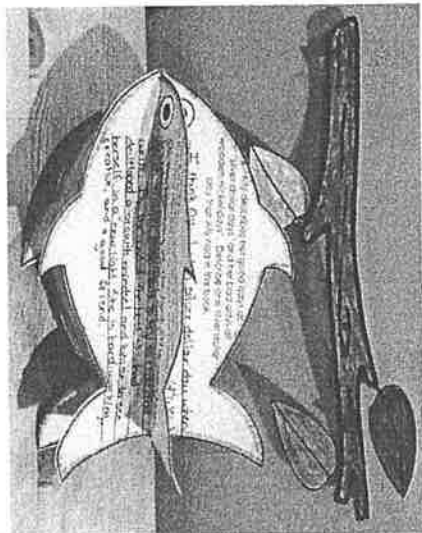
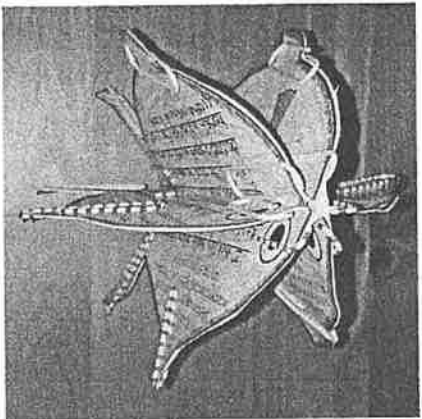
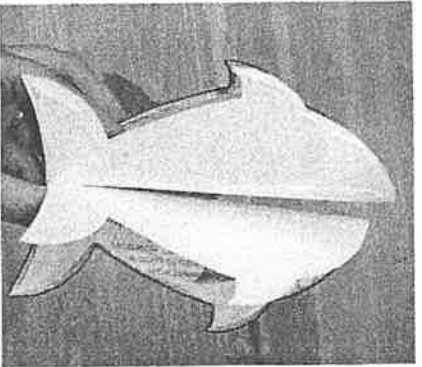
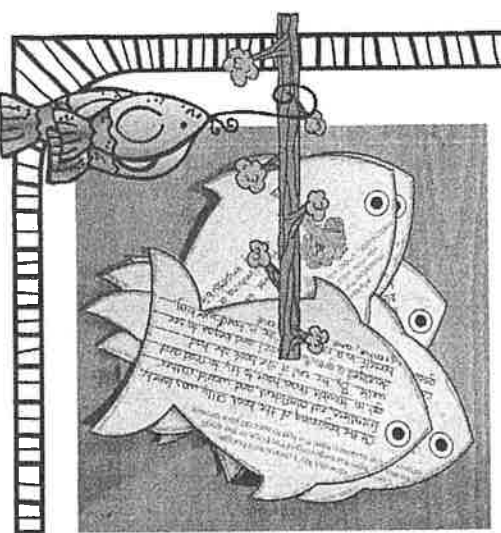


Ally describes her good days as "silver dollar days" and her bad days as "wooden nickel days". Describe one silver dollar day that Ally had in the book.



## Fish in a Tree Book-tivity - Assembly Instructions


1. Answer the questions given on each panel. When the answers are written, decorate the panels, and cut out carefully. \*Note: two of the panels included in this resource are optional (the blank templates) - you only need 6 panels to complete the craftivity.
2. Fold each fish shape in half (shapes are symmetrical so they will fold perfectly in half). Spread glue on the back of one half, and press the back of another shape to the glue. Secure with paper clips while the glue is drying. Continue this process until all 6 shape panels are glued together. NOTE: when attaching the last shape panel, be sure to spread glue on the back of both halves and attach it to the last shape panel, as well as the first.
3. Remove paperclips when glue is dry and admire your masterpiece. 😊

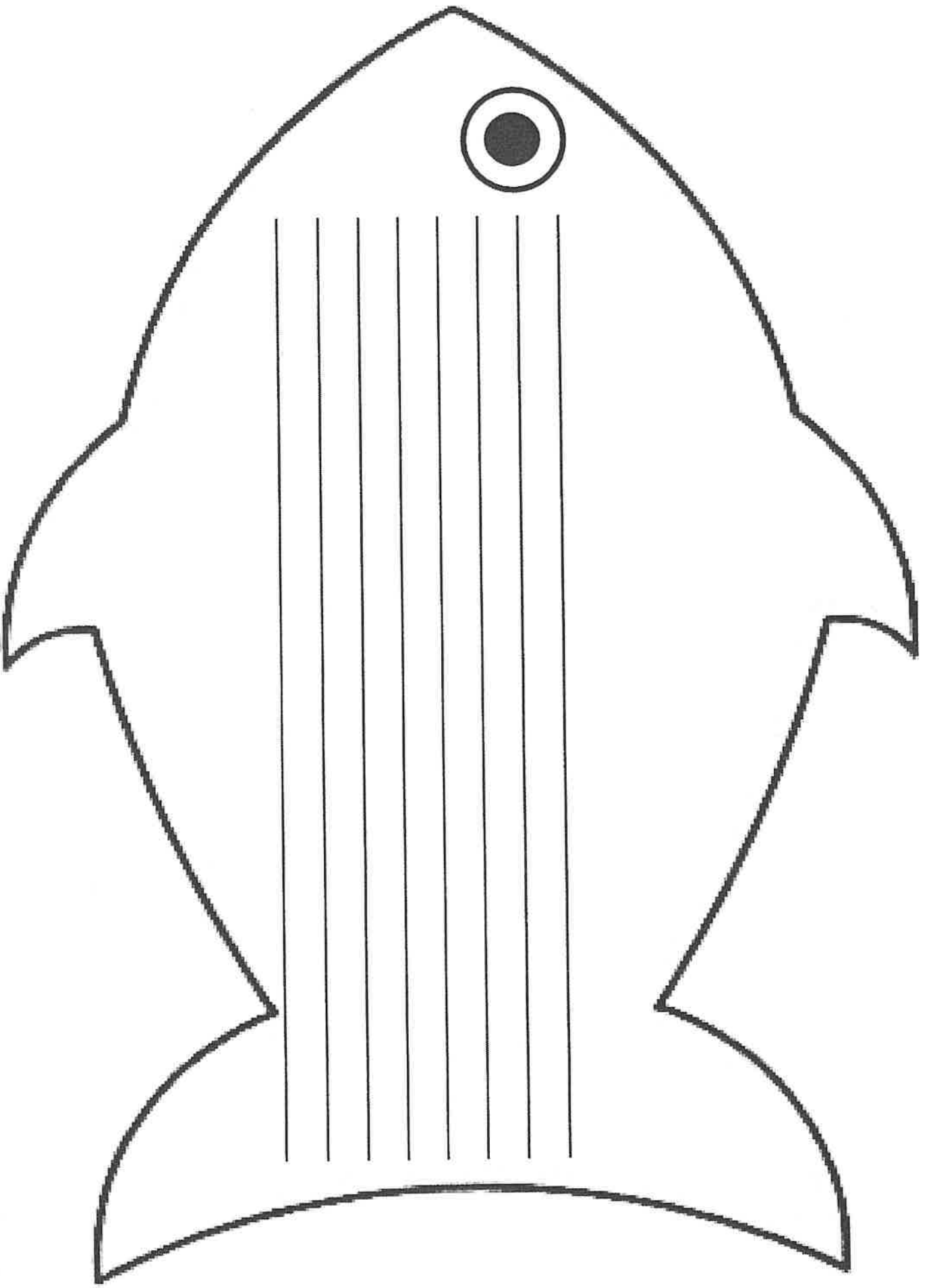


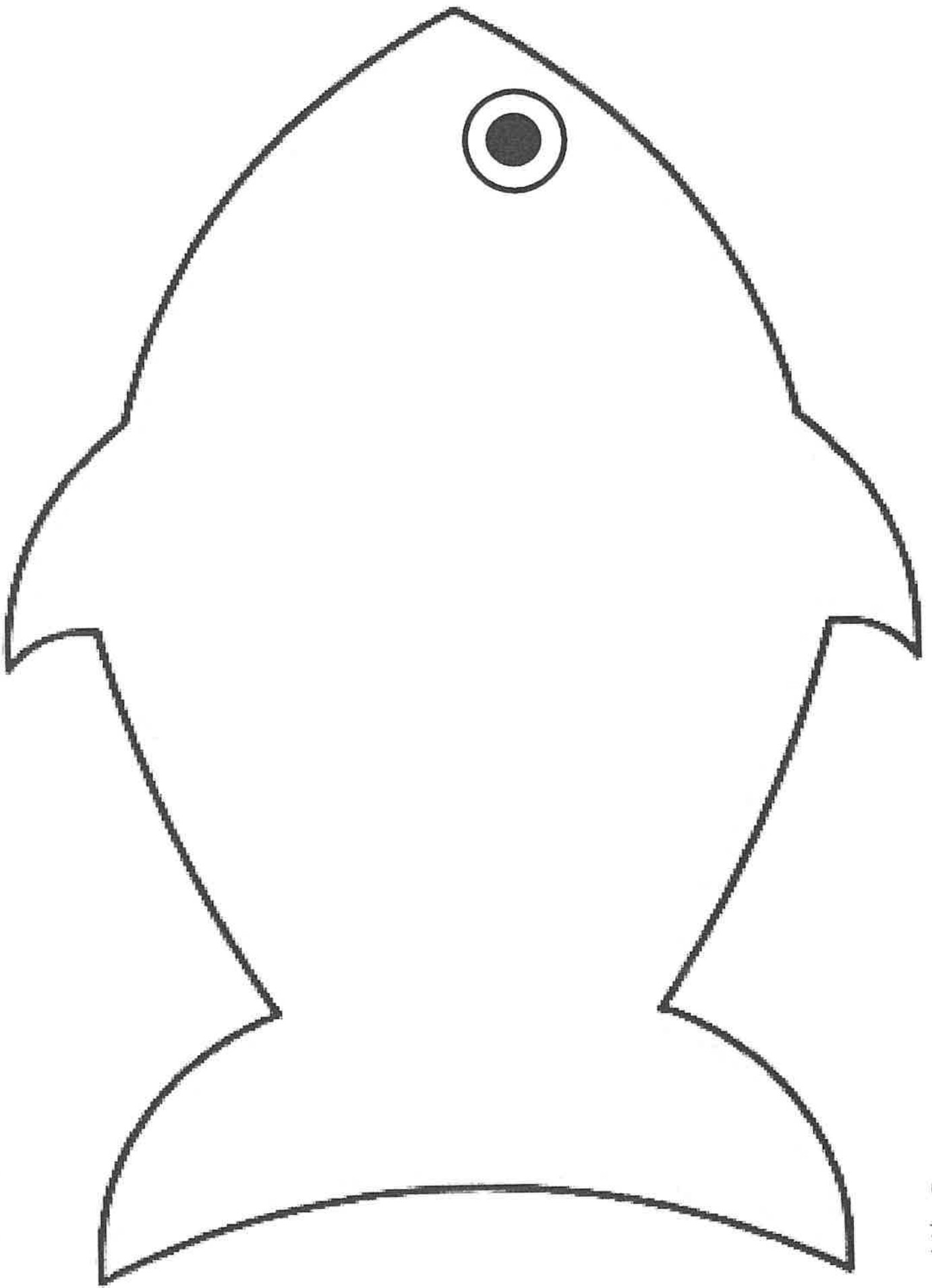
Ally keeps a sketchbook of impossible things. Create a drawing that you think would fit into Ally's "impossible" sketchbook. Under your picture, describe your drawing.
