



Graduation Procedures and Safety Protocol

All 8th grade students have a mandatory Teams call on May 15 at 9:30 a.m. The procedures and safety protocol below will be communicated to them.

Graduation Attire

Dress for graduation should be appropriate church attire including shoes. Please no spaghetti straps, strapless tops, or bare midriffs. Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt and tie.

Arrival Details

Students should arrive in the Cana Center by 5:00 p.m. with their cap and gown on. We will have chairs set out with student names to ensure everyone stays 6 feet apart. Students are not allowed to have cell phones with them.

Procedures for Graduation Mass

Please note, only parents and students are allowed in the Sanctuary. No siblings or children will be allowed to attend the Graduation Mass. As part of the Graduation Packet Pick-Up, (2) admission passes will be given to families. Parents will need to bring these passes to the Sanctuary on May 21. For family and friends not in attendance, the Graduation Mass will be livestreamed via the [Parish YouTube Channel](#).

Safety Protocol

- Temperatures of all attendees will be taken prior to entering the facility.
- All attendees must wear a face mask at all times. The school will not provide face masks, so please come prepared.
- Students and parents will have assigned seats inside the Sanctuary to ensure social distancing guidelines.
- This ceremony is a Mass and safety protocols for receiving communion will be communicated by our Pastor, Father Tom.
- Diplomas will not be issued at Graduation Mass. All diplomas will be included in the Graduation Packet on May 15.
- Photographers will be on hand to take pictures of students as their names are called. Parents are not allowed to leave their seat to take pictures. There will be no group photo opportunities.
- Dismissal from the Sanctuary will be communicated by our staff to ensure social distancing guidelines.
- Students may keep their graduation cap and gown after the ceremony.
