



Graduation Procedures and Safety Protocol

Please note, our Graduation will be held on the football field of John Paul II High School on Saturday, May 30 at 7:00 p.m. The procedures and safety protocol below will be communicated to our 8th graders on a mandatory Zoom call on Tuesday, May 26 at 9:30 a.m.

Graduation Attire

Dress for graduation should be appropriate church attire including shoes. Please no spaghetti straps, strapless tops, or bare midriffs. We recommend that ladies wear flat shoes or wedges, no heels. Gentlemen must wear a collared shirt and tie.

Arrival Details

Students should arrive at John Paull II High School by 6:30 p.m. with their cap and gown on. Students are not allowed to have cell phones on them during Graduation.

Procedures for Graduation

Please note, only parents and students are allowed to attend. No siblings or children will be allowed to attend Graduation. You will have received (2) admission passes as part of the Graduation Packet Pick-Up. Parents will need to bring these passes to Graduation on May 30. For family and friends not in attendance, the Graduation will be recorded and emailed to our 8th grade families.

Safety Protocol

- All attendees will be expected to answer a series of questions regarding their health and wellness before entering the event.
- All attendees must wear a face mask at all times. The school will not provide face masks, so please come prepared.
- Students will be seated on the football field and parents will have designated seating areas in the bleachers to ensure social distancing guidelines. There will be no assigned seats.
- Diplomas will not be issued at Graduation. You will receive diplomas in the Graduation Packet Pick-Up.
- A photographer will be on site to take pictures of students as their names are called. Parents are not allowed to leave their spot to take pictures. There will be no group photo opportunities.
- Dismissal will be communicated by our staff to ensure social distancing guidelines.
- Students may keep their graduation cap and gown after the ceremony.
